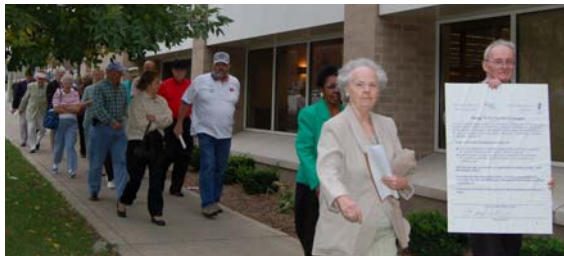
Today, the organization has grown to include more than 14,000 seniors and dozens of senior clubs who work on issues such as:

## Information About Group Membership

Any senior citizen group of ten (10) or more members, formal or informal, and any organization composed predominantly of senior citizens with ten (10) or more senior citizen members, is eligible for group membership in United Senior Action of Indiana with the exception of partisan political groups.

### Privileges:

- 1) To be notified of all general meetings and activities of United Senior Action in your area.
- 2) To receive a significant discount on USA individual membership dues for members of your group. (Affiliate Memberships are \$8 single/\$10 couple.)

### Responsibilities:

- 1) To promote USA Affiliate Memberships to your group members once a year.
- 2) To regularly share information about USA issues and activities with your group.
- 3) To schedule a presentation by a USA official once a year.
- 4) To appoint a representative and an alternate to serve as your group's representative to USA.
- 5) Have at least one representative at USA's Annual State Convention.
- 6) To pay annual dues based on our group's size:
  - \$25 for groups with fewer than 100 members
  - \$50 for groups with between 100 and 999 members
  - \$100 for groups with 1,000 or more members
